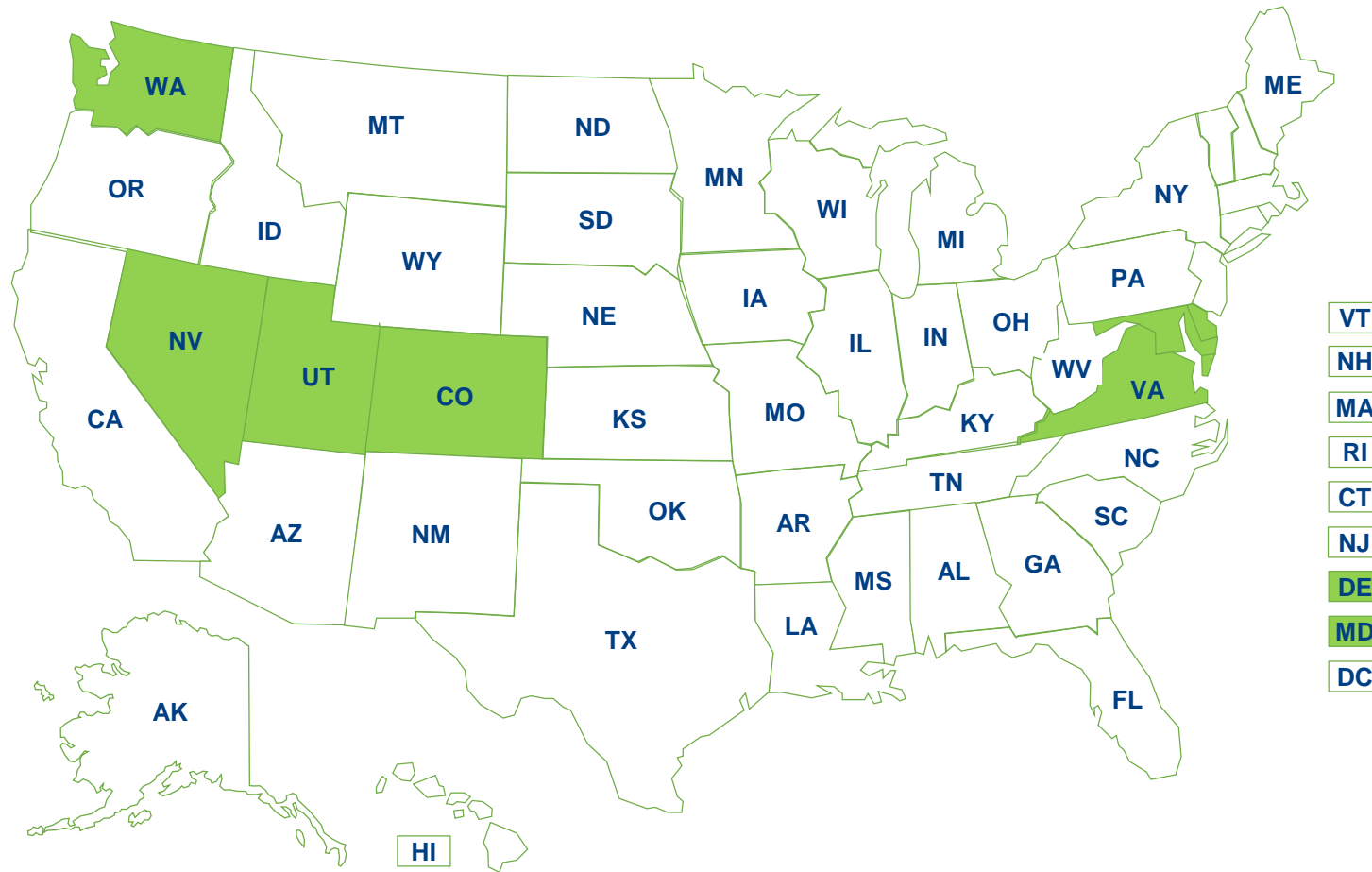

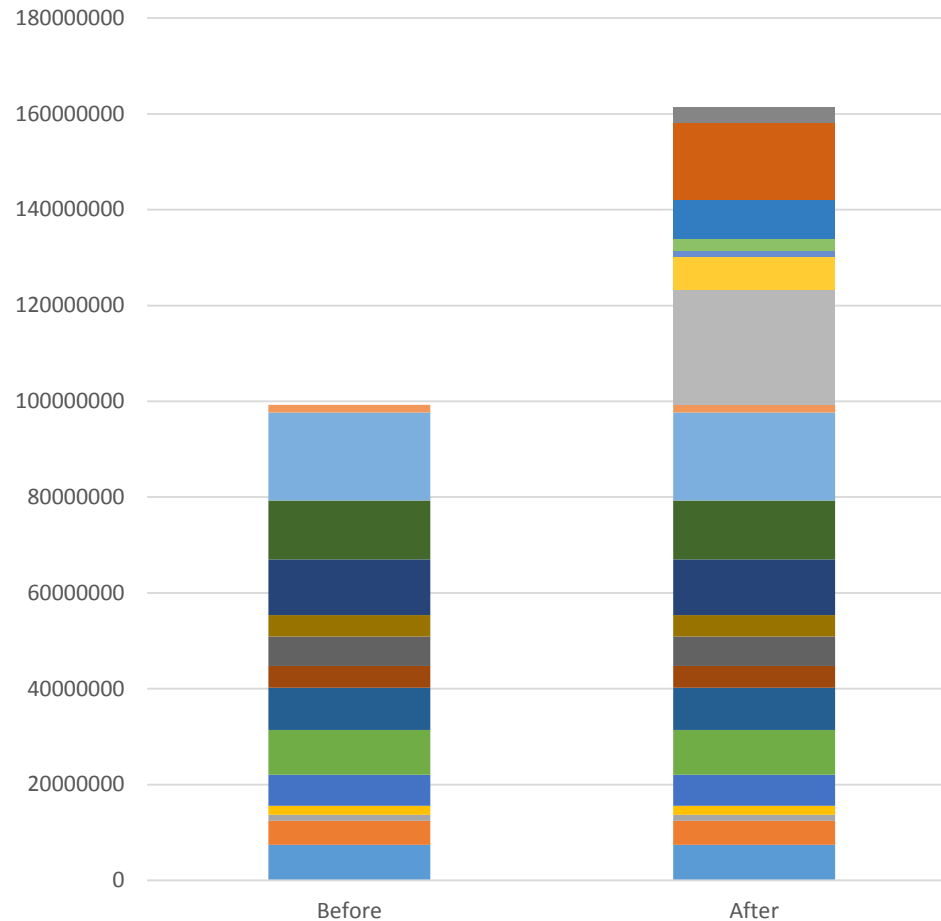

- New 7-member executive board
- Added 2 new ex-officio, non-voting seats
- Executive Director sets dues pay schedule
- Precise definition to responsibilities of the board versus the full membership



Finance and accounting

- FY16-17 budget: \$785,512
- Highest dues – PA at \$64,810
- Lowest dues – DC at \$19,590
- A first: Counties paid NM's \$24,359 dues
- All states are fully paid for current fiscal year
- Dues have dropped 23 to 31% for pioneers

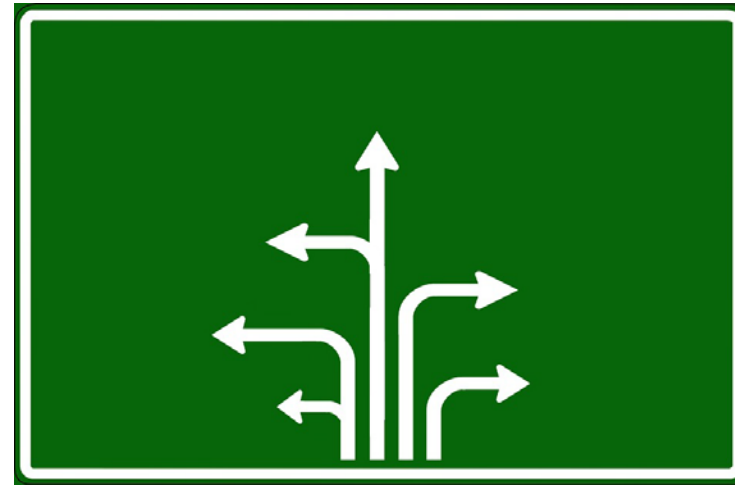
